

EVENT PROCEDURES

Safety & Health

While our staff members are not able to provide medical assistance, they have received crisis management protocol training. We have resources to best alleviate any emergencies. In the case of a severe medical emergency, Clark University police will be contacted to dispatch rapid response. If emergencies occur while committees are in session, the student's Faculty Advisor will be contacted immediately.

There are water filling stations all throughout our committee buildings. For committees being held in Jonas Clark and Sackler, the nearest water filling stations are located at the Jonas Clark basement (in front of the Faculty Advisor's room) or at the Jonas Clark first floor (next to the restrooms). For events being held at Daniel's Theater (Atwood), there are water filling stations located in the theater waiting area.

Registration

Registration will take place from 8 AM to 9 AM at the Daniel's Theater Reception at Atwood. Please ensure to arrive before 9 AM. All delegations might be registered before being permitted to attend any conference sessions. Any changes to delegate attendance must be communicated during registration.

Faculty Advisor Room

Jefferson 133 (JC 133) is the designated Faculty Advisor room. The room will count with refreshments and snacks for Faculty Advisors.

Badges and Placards

Delegates must wear their name badges at all times during the conference. Placards can be given back to any member of Secretariat or the Dais for recycling purposes.

EVENT PROCEDURES

Opening Ceremonies

Opening Ceremonies will take place from 9:00 AM to 9:30 AM at Atwood Hall Theater (Daniel's Theater). All delegations must be seated by 9:00 AM to start promptly. The Opening Ceremonies will include a series of statements and final instructions for the day. Once concluded, each committee will depart to their committee rooms under the chair's guidance. Please make sure to pay attention to when your committee is called.

Committee Sessions

Committees will take place in the following buildings: Jonas Clark, Sackler, Jefferson Academic Center, and Atwood Hall. Please see committee room roster above for more information. All delegates must be in their committee rooms by 9:40 AM.

Lunch

Lunch will be taking place at Harvest Table at Higgins, located at Higgins University Center. Chairs will be walking with delegates to the dining hall. Lunch is provided and lunch times vary per committee bloc.

Closing Ceremony

Closing ceremonies will initiate at 4:45 PM at Atwood Hall Theater. Please make sure to be seated by that time. Closing Ceremonies will consist of final statements and awards ceremony, in which we will recognize our committees' top performers. Once the ceremonies are concluded, Secretariat will remain at Atwood Hall for 30 more minutes to answer any last minute questions regarding ClarkMUN or awards. After this time, schools are free to leave our campus.
